As of today, \$2.2B needs to be allocated or get time extension approvals before June 30th

May CTC Meeting:

- 80 allocation extension requests -- \$393m
- 29 allocation requests -- \$40m

If the requests approved at May CTC meeting, the remaining \$1.77B needs to be allocated or get time extensions at June CTC meeting
