



Contracting Readiness

- Establish a list of qualified Signing & Striping contractors with Agreements
- Execute Task Orders
- Quick Delivery planning/outreach to design to installation = 3-6 months





Establish a Capital Improvement Program

- Safety Program \$2.6 million
 - Established in FY25/26 Budget Process
 - Using existing gas tax and Measure A transportation sales tax
- Quick Build CIP \$2 million
 - o Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation (RMRA Fund 2036) \$1 million
 - Major Street Construction (Fund 2007) \$1 million

 - Project Approval and Design
