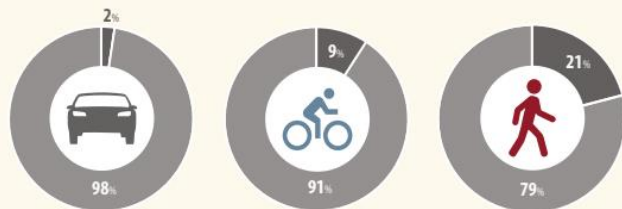

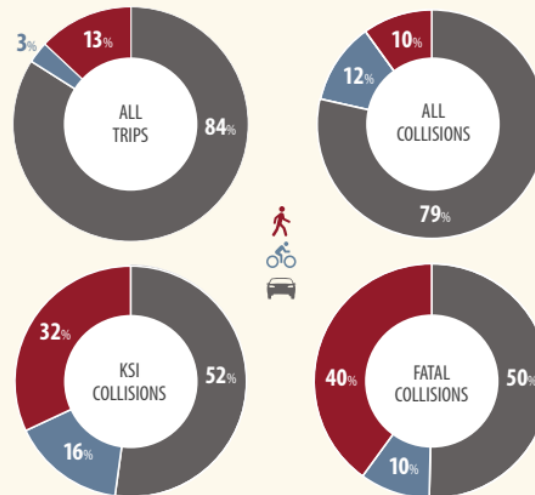
Disproportionately Ped & Bike

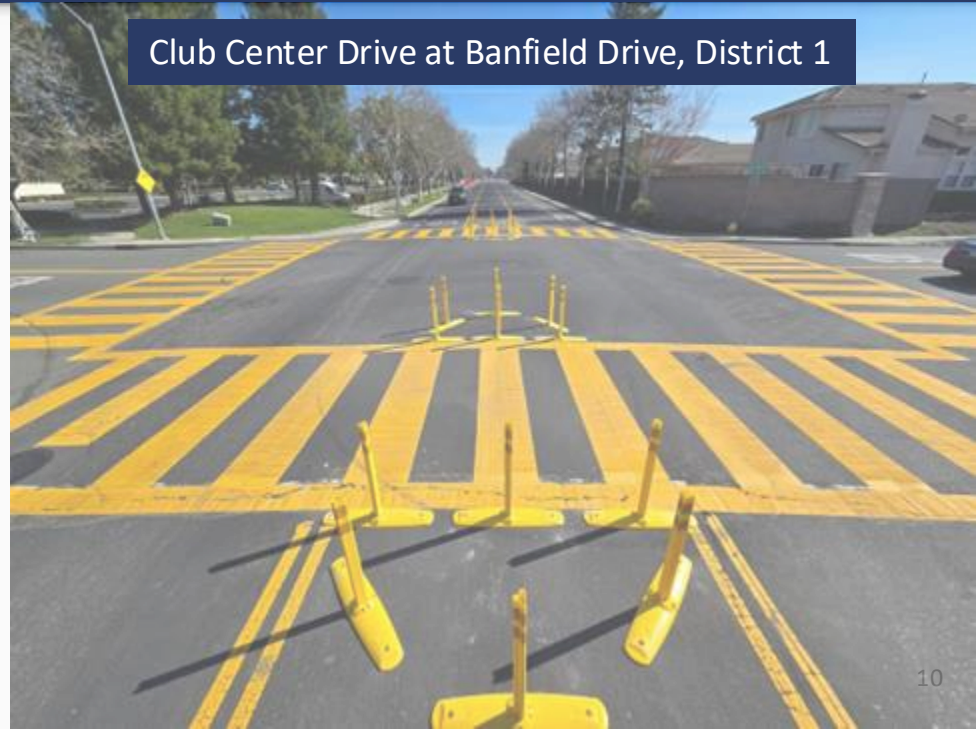

# Tier 2 Projects



## Features

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- Quick-build versions of VZ HIN Projects
- Delivered by Engineering Services
- Construction within a year
- One to three each year



## Example Locations

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- Marysville Blvd VZ
- Broadway at Stockton VZ
- Northgate Blvd VZ
- Fruitridge Road Improvements

## Contracting Readiness

- Establish a list of qualified Signing & Striping contractors with Agreements
- Execute Task Orders
- Quick Delivery – planning/outreach to design to installation = 3-6 months



# Establish a Capital Improvement Program

- Safety Program - \$2.6 million
  - Established in FY25/26 Budget Process
  - Using existing gas tax and Measure A transportation sales tax
- Quick Build CIP - \$2 million
  - Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation (RMRA Fund 2036) - \$1 million
  - Major Street Construction (Fund 2007) - \$1 million



# Ongoing Efforts

- Top 10 VZ Corridor Projects
  - Obtaining Grants
  - Project Approval and Design
- Vision Zero Action Plan Update
